## Technical Tour

There are three options available for the technical tour this year.

### Walking Tour

1. A walking tour from the CBD to the Port via some points of difference and interest for New Plymouth. Points of interest will be the Huatoki CBD development, foreshore pathway protection works, a hydroslide renewal at the aquatic centre, foreshore pathway, new residential and other coastal developments, and port challenges between industrial and recreational uses.

The total walk will be approximately 5kms.

### Cycling

2. A cycling tour from the CBD to the Port via Devon Street West and cycle lanes, to view the challenged northern outlet, Lake Rotomanu recreational area, the proposed foreshore pathway extension and bridge, foreshore pathway, foreshore protection works, hydroslide renewal and port development.

The cycle tour will cover approximately 15 kms.  
Bikes and helmets for delegates will be provided.

### Bus

3. A bus tour which will go out to the Bell Block Bypass construction project via the Northern Outlet (Strategic Transportation issues), look at recent industrial developments, the Waiwhakaiho Valley big box retail development, the proposed pathway extension from Lake Rotomanu. The bus will then travel to the Port viewing the proposed ½ roundabout at Moturoa and then up to the Mt Moturoa lookout to get a birds eye view of the port and surrounding infrastructure.

All groups will meet at the port for afternoon tea together, before buses transport you all back to the four official hotels.
