<p>Class 1W will make its debut in the revision to AS/NZS 1906.1:1993 when it is published later this year. Class 1W retroreflective film is being hailed as material of a high level of photometric performance especially at large to extreme entrance and observation angles yet do we really know whether such a performing material will really improve safety? This remit encourages discussion around whether there will be any safety improvement following a brief look at what exactly constitutes a Class 1W film.</p>
