<p>A series of roadside intercept surveys were undertaken within the greater Christchurch area to provide an important travel patterns input for the update of the Christchurch Transportation Model to the 2006 Census.</p> <p>This remit provides an overview of the survey design and planning, fieldwork experiences and procedures developed. A discussion is to be provided of sampling results obtained by the various survey methods adopted, which included roadside driver interviews, postcard survey distribution, and video survey distribution. Of particular interest was the response to video surveys, in which survey forms were sent to vehicle owners based on numberplates captured by video.</p>
